

Application for Board Appointment

The Paul Sawyier Public Library seeks to develop a strong and energetic Board of Trustees for the development of library services. Persons interested in being considered to be a Trustee should complete and return the application below along with a resume and a cover letter. The cover letter should explain the applicant's interest in the library and the services it provides to the community.

Applicants must:

- Live in Frankfort or Franklin County;
- Attend one board meeting per month (second Tuesday of each month at 5:30pm)
- · Be willing to complete state trustee certification within a year of appointment

The Paul Sawyier Public Library is required by Kentucky Revised Statute 173.490 to maintain a voting Board of five trustees. Trustees for the Voting Board are appointed by the County Judge-Executive with the approval of the Fiscal Court. The Library also has an Advisory Board consisting of five members, who are appointed by the Voting Board. Terms of all trustees, Voting and Advisory, last for four years with the possibility of re-appointment, one term for Voting Board members and possibly more for Advisory Board members. Trustees are not paid.

This application is for the PSPL Advisory Board.
